Petitioner is serving on the post of Group Instructor under
the Skill Development and Industrial Training Department, Haryana.

Instant writ petition was filed in the year 2018 assailing
the order dated 11.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) whereby petitioner was
transferred from Gurugram to Tosham.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued reply has
been filed.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

It emerges that petitioner had been adjusted at Gurugram
vide order dated 23.06.2017 on her own request. By virtue of interim
order passed by this Court on 15.05.2018 she has continued at
Gurugram.

The normal period of posting as per transfer policy framed
by the State Government itself is three years. Under such

circumstances the request of the petitioner having been acceded to and petitioner having been posted at Gurugram vide order dated 23.06.2017, she ought not to be displaced from Gurugram upto June 2020. This would facilitate the completion of the current academic session pertaining to her own children.

Instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of issuing directions to the respondent Department to keep the operation of the impugned order of transfer dated 11.05.2018 in abeyance till June 2020. It would be open for the Department to thereafter issue fresh orders of transfer as per the demands of exigencies of service.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
