The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.0327 dated 29.08.2018, registered under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Otherwise also, the allegations against the petitioner is that he was instrumental in preparing a fake Aadhar Card of the owner of the property, qua which the sale deed was intended to be fabricated. However, no said sale deed was ever executed. The petitioner is in custody since 18.04.2020. Although, the petitioner was involved in one more case, however, the petitioner is on bail in that case. The investigation is complete and hence the petitioner deserves to be released on bail.

Mr. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Jai Kumar has submitted that the petitioner is the main conspirator in this case in fabricating the Aadhar Card. However, it is not disputed that no sale deed was executed in this case. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 18.04.2020 and that the investigation of the case is already complete.

In view the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
