The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to take appropriate legal action in the context of representation dated 2.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a super stockiest of confectionary items and running two firms. He came in contact with respondent No.5 through a local LIC agent and borrowed some amount from him. Petitioner has already returned the amount to respondent No.5, but respondent No.5 is instrumental in harassing the petitioner through respondent No.4 and is demanding an amount of Rs.91 lakhs from the petitioner. Petitioner has maintained all the

record in terms of income tax returns and his bank accounts. Petitioner had given 20 signed cheques to respondent No.5 on account of transactions of borrowing money on interest. His wife had also given signed cheques to respondent No.5.

Precisely for the grievance in question, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 2.10.2020 before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.Harbir Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any response at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

In view of above, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and decide the representation dated 2.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
