On 17.07.2019, the following order was passed by this
Court while issuing notice of motion:-

“The learned counsel contends that the petitioners have lodged FIR No.137 dated 10.10.2018 registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural under Sections 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, but the police somehow is not investigating the matter fairly and has not even arrested any of the accused till date. The learned counsel submits that infact one of the accused i.e. respondent No.6 Lovepreet Singh happens to be employed in police due to which the police is all out to help the accused and has infact been pressurizing the petitioners to effect a compromise. It has further been submitted that petitioner No.1 Gurpreet Singh was forced to execute an affidavit regarding compromise and on the basis of the said affidavit, the accused have also filed an application for grant of anticipatory bail, which is presently fixed before this Court for 30.7.2019....”

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Sarwan

Singh, submits that 03 accused persons i.e. Lovepreet Singh – respondent No.6, Satwinder Pal Singh @ Kala Singh – respondent No.7 and one Ramandeep stands arrested and the challan has already been presented on 21.12.2019 and the matter is sub judice before the Illaqa Magistrate.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for redressal of their grievance, if any.
