The prayer of the petitioners, 37 in number, is with regard to release of their arrears of pay from the date of joining of candidates who were lower in merit. They also seek regular pay during the period of ad-hoc service rendered by them. In this regard, the petitioners got addressed legal notice dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-12) to the authorities concerned, but complain that they remained unmoved.

Mr. Keshav Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioners, would state that others similarly situated had filed *CWP No.14989 of 2020*, titled '*Tajbir and others V/s. State of Haryana and another*' before this Court

and the said writ petition was disposed of with suitable directions on 21.09.2020. A copy of the said order is placed on record.

For reasons alike as were mentioned in the aforestated order dated 21.09.2020 and in terms thereof, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents herein to consider the claim of the petitioners, as put forth in their legal notice dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-12), and take appropriate action thereon, as warranted. This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and, in any event, not later than two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

There shall be no order as to costs.
