Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the application is for withdrawal of the main writ petition.

In view of the averments made in the application and coupled with the fact that notice of motion has not yet been issued, the date in the main writ petition is preponed from 21.01.2021 and the same is taken up on Board today itself.

Application is disposed of.

Main case:

Instant writ petition was filed assailing the order dated 17.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), whereby an application moved by the petitioner under the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 had been dismissed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Panipat. Further challenge was to the order dated 15.05.2019 passed by the

District Magistrate-cum-Appellate Tribunal, Panipat (Annexure P-5)
dismissing the appeal that the petitioner had preferred.

Counsel submits that the dispute was inter se the petitioner and his son/respondent No.4. The petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and as such, seeks withdrawal of the same.

Even CM-12435-2020 raises a prayer for withdrawal of the petition and supported by an affidavit dated 16.11.2020 of the petitioner himself.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
