Prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of writ of certiorari for quashing of order Annexure P-8 dated 11.05.2017 passed by respondent No.1 i.e. the State Information Commission, Haryana vide which directions were issued to supply the information related to petitioner-school to respondent No.4. Prayer is also for quashing of letters Annexures P-5 and P-7 dated 26.05.2017 and 06.06.2017 respectively passed by respondent No.2 i.e. the District Education Officer, Panipat vide which the petitioner was directed to supply information.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that respondent No.4 does not require any information over and above the information which has already been supplied.

3. In the light of the position as noted above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the writ petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for respondent No.4, the writ petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
