1. Result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/DHBVNL, against category No.3, advertisement No.03/2016, has been produced in Court in sealed cover along with cut off marks obtained by the last selected candidate in the respective categories. Result on opening reveals the petitioner to have secured 68 out of 200 marks, whereas the last candidate selected in BCA category in UHBVNL/DHBVNL has secured 57/92 marks respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action on the result of the petitioner in accordance with.

3. Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection to the proposed course of action.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action in view of declaration of revised result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL on account of his having secured 68 marks, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
