GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-The Shahbad Coop. Sugar Mills Ltd., Shahabad Markanda, Haryana *inter alia* praying for quashing of the impugned order dated 20.10.2016 (Annexure P-23).

With the able assistance of counsel for the parties, order dated 20.10.2016, has been perused. In the said order, the Tribunal had imposed 50% of the assessed damages on the appellant-establishment along with entire assessed interest. With these directions, the appeal filed by the petitioner before the Appellate Tribunal, was disposed of.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2 submits that the above said order dated 20.10.2016, passed by the Appellate Tribunal, was challenged by respondents No.1 & 2 by filing ***CWP-8628-2017 titled as***

Central Board of Trustees vs. The Shahbad Coop. Sugar Mills Ltd. The said writ petition along with other writ petitions have been allowed and this Court vide judgment dated 07.08.2018, has quashed the impugned order of the Appellate Tribunal. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the said impugned order is the same order dated 20.10.2016 (Annexure P-23), which is under challenge in the present writ petition. He therefore submits that in this view of the matter, no further orders are called for in the present writ petition as the same has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.
