MANOJ BAJAJ, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has invoked revisional jurisdiction of this Court by way of revision petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to challenge the order dated 16.09.2020 whereby his suit stands adjourned to 12.11.2020 in the wake of the pandemic COVID-19 and prays for issuance of directions to the trial Court to adjudicate the suit urgently.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the suit is at the final stage as the arguments of the plaintiff (petitioner) have already been concluded, and further a perusal of the order dated 13.01.2020 reveals that the past arguments of the defendants have also been addressed.

After hearing the learned counsel and considering the above stage of the civil suit, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the power of Superintendence under Articles 227 Constitution of India, as the country continues to be in the throes of pandemic COVID-19

The revision petition is dismissed.
