Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 19 dated 22.11.2018 registered under Sections 406, 418, 420, 477, 34 and 120-B IPC and Section 3 of the Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013, [Section 3(2) (v) the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 since deleted], at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the Society was registered in the year 2001 and working efficiently but because of loss in the Society, the due amount Rs. 17 lakhs could not be paid back to the complainant.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Hisar, in the Court today, which is taken on record. In the report, it has been stated that there are three more FIRs registered against the petitioner and the Society is being run by the family members.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
