Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents to get the detenue namely Makhan Singh Gill, released from the illegal custody of the respondents.

Reply by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police (Investigation), District Hoshiarpur is on record and as per the reply, Makhan Singh Gill, is nominated in 06 FIRs.

Counsel for the State has argued that on 04.10.2020, one FIR No.204 dated 04.10.2020 has been registered under Sections 120-B, 121, 153 IPC, 25/54/59 of the Arms Act and 17, 18, 18-B and 20 of the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act, 1967, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur against the said Makhan Singh and Davinder Singh and they have been arrested and recovery of illegal weapons was effected. It is further submitted that the detenue is not in illegal custody and has been arrested, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
