The petitioners-parents of detenue-Anju have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of detenue-Anju from illegal custody of respondents No.5 to 7.

Warrant Officer appointed by the Registry in compliance with order dated 08.10.2020 passed by Coordinate Bench has submitted his report in sealed cover which is opened and report is taken out and placed on record.

In his report, the Warrant Officer has mentioned that detenue-Anju had performed marriage with respondent No.4 Jaydeep and was residing with him out of her own wish. The petitioners also made statements dated 08.10.2020 before the police officer that they had no objection to marriage of their daughter with Jaydeep.

In view of the report of the Warrant Officer, no further action is required to be taken on the present habeas corpus petition which is disposed of as having become infructuous.
