The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for direction to respondent no.2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from respondent no.5 to 8.

The petitioner claims that on account of injuries inflicted by the private respondents, left little finger on middle phalanx of the petitioner has been amputated. He contends that inspite of complaint made, the police has not registered the FIR and the petitioner is being pressurized to enter into compromise.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who has appeared pursuant to supply of an advance copy of the writ petition, on instructions from ASI Yashpal has submitted that in the preliminary inquiry made, the police has formed an opinion that the alleged injury caused could be self inflicted.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered

appropriate to relegate the petitioner to the alternate remedy of filing criminal complaint before the Magistrate.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
