The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Vasundra Anand, APP, accepts notice on behalf of U.T., Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the U.T., Chandigarh has submitted that the police tried to find out that the petitioners and their status to assess whether there is any threat to their life and liberty or not. However, none of the petitioners were found at the address given by them. Therefore, there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Otherwise also, except the baled statement of the petitioners, there is nothing on the record to even remotely suggest that the petitioners apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition.
Dismissed.
