1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for willful and intentional disobedience of orders of this Court Annexure P/1 dated 08.09.2020, in CWP No.13879 of 2020, in case titled as Dinesh Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/1 dated 08.09.2020, CWP No.13879 of 2020, was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 in the writ petition, to take a decision on the representation dated 19.08.2020, within two weeks from the date of order and in case request of the petitioner was to be declined, a speaking order be passed and communicated to the petitioner but despite lapse of aforementioned period of time, needful has not been done.

under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against them for non-compliance with the orders of this Court Annexure P/1 dated 08.09.2020.

5. Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has produced copy of order dated 12.10.2020, passed in compliance with the order of this Court Annexure P/1 dated 08.09.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that he does not press the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 12.10.2020, in accordance with law.

6. The same is not objected to by learned DAG, Punjab.

7. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for.
