The petitioner alleges that respondent No.4 established physical relations with her on the pretext of marriage, but, thereafter, refused to marry her. Despite representation dated 10.8.2020 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 3.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted before respondent No.2, the police is not taking any action thereupon, till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 7, at this stage nor a reply is necessary.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 10.8.2020 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 3.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
