Case taken up through video conferencing.

By way of filing present criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner – Gurpreet Singh craves for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing official respondents No.1 to 4 to look into his grievances and take legal action against private respondents No.5 to 7 for stealing the gold ornaments and other valuable documents.

The grouse of the petitioner is mainly against his estranged wife Rajinder Kaur (respondent No.5), who is alleged to have taken away gold ornaments and other documents from the matrimonial home. According to the petitioner, he had reported the matter to the police i.e. SHO Zira vide written complaint dated 8.9.2020, copy thereof being Annexure P-1 and Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur vide

written complaint dated 28.9.2020, copy thereof being Annexure P-2, but no action is said to have been taken in the matter so far.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the grievances of the petitioner as contained in representation Annexure P2 and to take necessary action in the matter, if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case, expeditiously.
