Petitioners who were serving on the post of Assistant Jamadar under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited seek a mandamus to direct the respondent/Corporation to release in their favour the financial benefits of 9/16 years time bound promotional scales.

Apparently, till date no final decision as regards claim of the petitioners has been taken.

Counsel representing the respondent/Corporation undertakes that a final decision on the claim of the petitioners would be taken positively within a period of four weeks from today and a reasoned order would be communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

In the light of such undertaking furnished, writ petition is disposed of.

Needless to observe that it would be open for the petitioners to approach this Court afresh in the eventuality of any order being passed

which is detrimental to their interest.
