In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioners is for grant of benefit keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CWP-2605 of 1998 decided on 02.07.2014 which judgement was upheld in LPA No.1991 of 2014 decided on 29.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that judgement which is being relied upon by the learned counsel for the petitioners to claim the benefit has already been stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 24.01.2020 passed in SLP (Civil) No.45053 of 2019.
