The challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the appointment of respondent No.5 to the post of Principal, posted at DAV College, Pundri, District Kaithal. On 04.11.2020 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.5 was not having the requisite qualification of 15 years of experience for applying to the post of Principal upto the last date of filing application.

On a query put by the Court to learned counsel for the petitioner with regard to the fact that the petitioner had stated in his application form, which is at page 54 of the paper book, that he had undergraduate experience of 15 years and research experience of 2 years and 5 months, which adds on to 17 years and that the rule pertaining to the direct recruitment to the post of Principal reproduced at page 8 of the paper book would show that total experience of

15 years of teaching/research in the Universities/colleges was required, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for some more time to clarify this aspect.

On his request, adjourned to 16.12.2020.”

Today counsel submits that he does not wish to press the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the same is dismissed as not pressed.
