The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.120 dated 27.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149, 379-B at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

The case of the prosecution is that on 26.08.2020 the petitioner and his co-accused, who were armed with dandas/lathis, attacked the complainant and his cousin-Jasdeep Singh and as a result of such incident the complainant and his cousin-Jasdeep Singh received 11 and 5 injuries respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case; he is a young man aged 19 years; there is no other criminal case against him and the main accused in the case is Gagandeep Virk and not the petitioner.

A perusal of the FIR reveals that the petitioner has been specifically named therein as one of the assailants who, alongwith his co-accused, attacked and mercilessly beat up the complainant and his cousin and caused as many as 11 injuries on the complainant and 5 on his cousin. Further, co-accused Gagandeep Virk is alleged to have snatched the complainant's gold chain.

In view of the above serious allegations against the petitioner and for the reason that recovery of the alleged weapon used by the petitioner as also of the gold chain is to be made from his co-accused this Court considers that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

Dismissed.
