REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The precise grievance of the petitioner is that she was allowed financial assistance under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 (In short 'Rules of 2006) on account of death of her husband Sh. Vijay Kumar who was working as class-IV (Group-D) on regular post but since January 2020, the same has not been released resulting in hardship to the petitioner and her 8 years old daughter – Kritika.

Without examining the merits of allegations raised in petition, the petition stands disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall make a detailed representation to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation/ Nagar Nigam, Ambala within a period of 15 days. In case such a representation is made, the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation/ Nagar Nigam, Ambala shall take a final decision in the matter within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of representation. In case the petitioner had any grievance to express against decision taken by the

aforesaid authority, she would be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate remedy in law.
