All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in a similar petition filed by the other petitioners, bearing CWP No.16566 of 2020, a co-ordinate Bench has already passed an order yesterday, directing the Vice-Chancellor of the respondent University to consider the case of the petitioners therein as regards allowing them to appear in the examination towards obtaining a degree of Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medical Sciences and consequently, this petition may be disposed of with the same directions.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of in terms of what has been contended, to the effect that the Vice Chancellor of the respondent University would consider the

case of the petitioners for allowing them to appear in the aforesaid examination, (immediately), because the examination itself is stated to be starting on 10.10.2020 (tomorrow).

Consequently, the petitioners would be at liberty to meet the Vice Chancellor early in the morning on 10.10.2020.

It is to be noticed that Mr. Amit Rao, learned counsel for the respondent University, is also present through video conferencing.
