Learned counsel for the respondents in the light of the reply, which has been filed, submits that the claim of all the petitioners except petitioner No.11, has been sympathetically considered and additional seats have been created where the petitioners would be adjusted within a period of 10 days, provided they fulfill the requisite criteria including the verification of the documents. As regards, petitioner No.11, it has been stated that since the said petitioner did not fill the form for counselling, his candidature could not be considered in the first counselling.

Learned counsel for the petitioners accepts the submission of the learned counsel for the respondents. He, however, states that petitioner No.11 may be granted an opportunity to participate in the second counselling as he belongs to the scheduled caste category and seats are available, therefore, his case may be considered.

Learned counsel for the respondents asserts that the said contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners is acceptable provided petitioner No.11 participates in the second counselling and the seats are available.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
