The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.157 dated 21.08.2020, registered under Sections 307 and 34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Dujana, District Jhajjar.

On 16.10.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon pendency of CRM-M- No.32587 of 2020 to contend that the matter stands settled between the parties.

Notice of motion for 24.11.2020.

At this stage, Mr. Hitesh Verma, Advocate appears on behalf of the complainant and admits the factum of compromise between the parties.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.10.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Krishan Kumar admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

Learned counsel for the complainant also admitted the aforesaid position.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 16.10.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
