The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The case of the petitioners is that they have solemnized marriage on 11.10.2020 and the Marriage Certificate(Annexure P-3) is attached with the present petition. The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondent Nos.5 to 7 and apprehend that they may implicate them in some false cases.

Learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 7 submits that they have no objection, if the petitioners have solemnized marriage. However, if anything happens with the petitioners, respondents No.5 to 7 would not be responsible for it.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

However, in case, the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their lives and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall look into the grievance of the petitioners and shall act in accordance with law.
