The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.51 dated 19.06.2020, registered under Sections 323, 376, 450, 506 IPC and Section 3 (2)(v) of SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Jind, District Jind.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner had emerged on account of some misunderstanding between the parties. Now the matter has been amicably settled between the parties. There is no other case pending against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2020.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and Mr. Kamal Mor, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Anita Kumari, has submitted that there are specific allegations against the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve any concession of bail but it is not disputed that even the police has been informed by the complainant qua the settlement of the dispute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties. He has the instructions to submit that the complainant does not have any objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

In view the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
