The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 330 dated 14.10.2019, under Section 392 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and the co-accused have already been arrested and recovery has been effected from them.

Heard.

The allegations in the FIR are that while the complainant was coming home on his motorcycle, he was intercepted by three unknown persons and they had snatched his bike, mobile phone and the money which he was carrying. The co-accused, namely, Harjinder Singh, was arrested and he had made statement that the petitioner was one of the other persons, who were with him and had participated in the occurrence. In view of the serious

allegations the petitioner being allegedly involved in the snatching, I do not find it to be a case which would warrant grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
