ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 15.02.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Raikot, district Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein two persons have been specifically named and specific injuries have been attributed to them. It is stated in the FIR that 4-5 other persons had also accompanied two named accused and they had given kick blows to the injured- Gagandeep Singh. Learned counsel has filed a copy of the MLR of the injured- Gagandeep Singh which indicates that there is one lacerated wound on his head. A copy of the MLR is taken on record. He also contends that the incident is an outcome of a sudden quarrel and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-3.

This Court, by the order dated 28.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Pal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 28.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
