This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detenue Davinder Singh, son of the petitioner, who is in the custody at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply along with report of the Warrant Officer through e-mail. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

As per the report of the warrant officer, the detenue was found standing outside the gate of police station, Sirhind at the time of raid, hence prima facie, the alleged detenue could not be said to be in illegal custody of the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has since returned to his home.

The instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infrcutuous.
