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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

This petition relates to admission in MDS Course of Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics for the Session 2018-2019 in the respondent No. 4 - Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital, Sector 25, Chandigarh.

Admittedly, admissions have already been made and the petitioner has been admitted in another college in the State of Karnataka in the second round of counselling. However, she is aggrieved by the fact that she has not been allotted the seat

in the college of her choice on account of certain illegalities committed by the authorities.

Be that as it may, as the admission relates to the Session 2018-2019, which cannot be disturbed at this belated stage, we find no reason to now take a decision on the issue raised by the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities seeking compensation if so permissible in law. It goes without saying that if the petitioner does so, the respondent-authorities shall take a decision, either ways, expeditiously in accordance with law.
