AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner herein belongs to the handicapped category and had applied in pursuance to the advertisement dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) for the post of Multipurpose Health Worker (male). He asserts that his claim has not been considered by the respondents on the ground that he has filled-up a wrong category.

Counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the fact that even if the candidature of the petitioner is considered under the handicapped category, he would still not make the grade as the merit secured by him is 332, whereas, the last selected candidate, who had been appointed under the handicapped category has obtained 344 marks.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any merit in the present writ petition and the exercise would be in futility to even consider the aspect with regard to the wrong filling-up the application form.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
