Having considered the submissions, made by learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for respondents No.3 and 4, we do not find any ground to interfere in the order dated 11.09.2020, passed by the learned Single Judge while dismissing the application for preponment of the hearing of main case.

Learned counsel for the appellants has pointed out that because of the stoppage of supply at Ambala, appellants were suffering but this aspect has been dealt with by the learned Single Judge especially in the light of the statement made by counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 before the Court that the appellants have an option to receive supply either from

Panipat or from Sangrur. So it is not a case where the appellants cannot receive the supply from any source. The matter is to come up before the learned Single Judge for hearing on 28.10.2020 then it would be open to the appellants to assert the points with regard to the grievances.

It has been asserted by learned counsel for the appellants that prior to stopping the supply from Ambala, no notice was given to the appellants, who are transporters. This aspect will also be open for the appellants to agitate before the learned Single Judge when the case comes up for consideration.

For the reasons, stated above, the present appeal is disposed of.
