Limited prayer of the petitioner is that he has constructed a residential house which does not create hindrance in public utility like street light or sewerage etc. Thus, it would be in the interests of justice if the Trust exempts his residential area from acquisition.

Mr. Pathela, at the outset, submits that a resolution has been passed by the Trust exempting 10.75 Marla in Khasra No.9993 owned by the petitioner. Regarding open area, compensation stands deposited. He further submits that the constructed area of the petitioner shall not be demolished.

In view of above statement, grievance of the petitioner has been redressed. No cause of action survives.

Petition stands disposed of.
