The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 188
dated 08.09.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC registered
at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that
he does not press the petition qua petitioner No. 1.

Accordingly, petition qua petitioner No. 1 is dismissed as
withdrawn.

Vide order dated 15.10.2020, this Court while granting the
concession of interim anticipatory bail to petitioners No. 2 and 3 were
directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners No. 2 and 3
have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer
required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed qua petitioners No. 2 and 3. The order dated 15.10.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners No. 2 and 3, is made absolute. However, the petitioners No. 2 and 3 shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
