AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

1 By this petition the petitioner has challenged the action of the Tribunal in issuing notice of motion but not granting interim relief.

2 On the asking of Court Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India with Mr.Namit Kumar, Advocate accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.5 & 6.

3 During hearing all the learned counsel have agreed that it would be in the interest of justice if the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh (for short 'the Tribunal') decide the main case expeditiously. It has transpired that the respondents No.1 to 4 have already filed their replies before the Tribunal.

4 Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India has very fairly stated that respondents No.5 & 6 will also file their replies on or before 01.12.2020 with an advance copy to the counsel for the applicant

before the Tribunal so that replication if any is filed on or before 04.12.2020. It has further been agreed that none of the parties would seek an adjournment so that the main case will be heard and decided on the date fixed i.e. 07.12.2020.

5 In the meantime, any selection made would be subject to the result of the original application.

6 Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India has stated that in the event of any selection being finalized the selected candidates will be informed about the pendency of the OA so that they may take an action which they may deem it fit.

7 Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid observations.

8 Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
