This revision by the wife arises out of the appellate order dated 21.05.2019 passed by the Additional District Judge, Patiala in AAO No.137-2018 of 2020, thereby the Appellate Court set aside the judgment and decree dated 25.05.2018 of the trial Court and remanded the matter for consideration afresh after giving three opportunities each to the parties to record their evidence.

By order dated 22.08.2019 this Court stayed the proceedings before the trial Court.

While so, the petitioner-wife filed CM No.8763-CII-2020 stating that the parties had amicably settled their disputes and that she wishes to withdraw the revision.

In the light of the aforestated development, the present revision does not need to be adjudicated on merits.

The application is accordingly ordered and the civil revision is dismissed as withdrawn.
