The contempt petition has been filed against the order dated 6.2.2020.

The writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for regular promotion against the available vacancies on the date of retirement of the petitioner within three months.

Admittedly, the matter was considered and the order dated 16.7.2020 rejecting the claim of the petitioner has since been passed.

In view of the above, no contempt is made out. The contempt petition is dismissed accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, vehemently argued that the order has been passed without taking into consideration the seniority as directed by the Division Bench in LPA No.37 of 2017.

The speaking order having been passed, the same cannot be gone into in the contempt petition. Therefore, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the order in any manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
