1. In view of the judgment of the Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court in *Indore Development Authority v. Manoharlal AIR 2020 SC 1496*, none of the grounds/issues raised in this petition survive as they all stand answered against the Petitioners.

2. This petition is accordingly dismissed.

3. The status quo order, if any, hereby stands vacated.

4. As far as Petitioner No. 4 is concerned, in view of the statement in the reply filed by the Respondents that the award in respect of her land could not be announced due to stay order dated 26th April, 2000 in CWP No. 4402 of 2000, which was disposed of on 21st October, 2014, it is clarified that notwithstanding any subsequent stay order in any other writ petition, it will be open to the Respondents to proceed to announce the award in respect of

the Petitioner No. 4's land. The Court also grants liberty to the Petitioner No. 4 to approach the Land Acquisition Collector for disbursal of the compensation due to her, in accordance with law. It is also clarified that if the Petitioner No. 4 makes a representation invoking S. 101-A of the 2013 Act, it will be for the Respondent authorities to examine it and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.
