The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ petition in the nature of habeas corpus for release of the detenues named in para No.3 of the petition as Nishan Singh, Gurinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Sandeep Singh and Sucha Singh from illegal custody of respondent No.5 by appointment of a Warrant Officer.

Vide order dated 12.07.2019, the registry was directed to appoint a Warrant Officer to search the whereabouts of the alleged detenues at the address mentioned in the writ petition or at any other place(s) as may be indicated by the petitioner and if they are found in illegal custody of respondent No.5, to get them released forthwith.

Accordingly, Bhag Singh Virk was appointed as Warrant Officer who conducted the search and submitted his report dated 15.07.2019. In his report, the Warrant Officer has submitted that none of the persons was found in the police station and as per GD No.016

dated 13.07.2019 entered in the computer regarding his visit it was stated that neither the police has arrested Nishan Singh, Gurinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Sandeep Singh and Sucha Singh nor any FIR/case/complaint is pending with the police in Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran against them.

In view of the report, no further action is required to be taken in the present habeas corpus which is disposed of accordingly.
