[The aforesaid presence is being recorded through video conferencing since the proceedings are being conducted in virtual court]

Petitioner is a resident of village Dhunda, Tehsil Khadoor Sahib, District Tarn Taran. Although by referring to application (P-3) dated 27.10.2015 made by the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat to Tehsildar for demarcation of stated parcels of land under the unauthorized occupation of the resident of village upon the land belonging to the Gram Panchayat, prayer is for direction to revenue officials to conduct the demarcation of stated area in P-3, however, petitioner is primarily aggrieved by the encroachment made by one Joginder Singh son of Kishan Singh and his sons upon a public *raasta* comprised in Khasra No.344(1-5) as also an effort to forcibly carve out a *raasta* from the private land of the petitioner

bearing Khasra No.89//14(8-0). He thus is also claiming a direction for conduct of the demarcation in Khasra No.344 as also his own land in Khasra No.89//14(8-0).

On the previous date of hearing learned State Counsel was directed to seek instructions in respect of initiating and completing the demarcation of the areas as claimed by the Gram Panchayat described in Annexure P-3.

At the time of resumed hearing, learned State Counsel on instructions from Ms. Rajinder Kaur BDPO, Khadoor Sahib submits that as far as the petitioner is concerned, if he moves an application for demarcation along with requisite fee the same shall be entertained and demarcation conducted in accordance with law within four weeks of such application along with requisite fee. As regards the complete demarcation of the land belonging to the Panchayat in the village, they shall be undertaken in a phased manner and unauthorized encroachments removed.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that nothing more survives for adjudication in the present case.

Dismissed as infructuous.
