Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas-Corpus for release of the detenues, detail whereof was given in paragraph 2 of the petition.

On 14.10.2020, the following order was passed:-

“It is alleged that the detenues named in para No.2 of the petition have been kept in illegal custody by respondents No.4 & 5. Despite representation dated 07.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) having been made, no action has been taken by the District Magistrate.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice and waives service.

Respondent No.2 is directed to visit the farm house of respondents No.4 & 5 on 16.10.2020 and get the alleged detenues released in case they are found to be in illegal custody. Respondent No.3 shall provide all necessary help.

Status report be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 22.10.2020.”

Sh. Saurabh Mohunta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has forwarded a copy of the status report filed by way of affidavit of District Magistrate, Kaithal, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the alleged detenues have been got released and they have returned to their residence.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
