At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be
allowed to withdraw this petition. At this stage, learned State counsel
submits that no detinue was found confined at the spot when the team
constituted by District Magistrate, Sonapat visited the spot on 20.10.2020.

As per order dated 14.10.2020 passed by Coordinate Bench of
this Court, direction was given to District Magistrate, Sonapat to inspect the
spot on 16.10.2020 only. So, at this stage, it is difficult to ascertain as to if
the allegations made in the petition were false and frivolous, the reason
being direction issued by this Court was not complied with in letter and
spirit.

Accordingly, in the light of the aforesaid statement made by the
counsel for the petitioner, this petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn
with no further observation.
