GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

(1) The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

(2) Notice of motion. Mr. HS Sitta, AAG Punjab accepts notice through video conferencing. In view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their reply, at this stage.

(3) The present petition has been filed by petitioner Manpreet Kaur, *inter alia*, with a prayer seeking a direction to the respondents No.3&4 not to repeatedly raid the matrimonial house of the petitioner and falsely implicate her or her family members in any false complaint submitted by the private respondents as they are inimical towards the family of the petitioner after occurrence dated 25.09.2020 wherein the grievous injury caused to the aunt of the petitioner and FIR has also been lodged against her despite the fact that occurrence is result of the aggression of private respondents. It is further prayed to provide police protection for harvesting the paddy crop standing in 10 acres of land owned by the petitioner's father (at present lodged at Patti Jail) wherein she is having coparcenary rights.

(4) Learned counsel submits that for the same/similar grievance made in the present petition, the petitioner has made representations dated 11.10.2020 to respondents No.2&4.

(5) Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present petition by directing the competent authority to look into the grievance raised in the representations and decide the same in accordance with law within two month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(6) So ordered.
