The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.257 dated 19.08.2019 under Sections 307, 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.10.2020 on the premise that the parties have already entered into a compromise on 04.11.2019. The said compromise has been given effect in CRM-M No.51676 of 2019 and CRM-M No.258 of 2020 when co-accused namely Jagga Singh and Labh Singh

were granted interim bail in CRM-M No.51676 of 2019 and co-accused Pargat Singh @ Kala was granted interim bail in CRM-M No.258 of 2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 16.10.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 16.10.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
