Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 58 days in filing the present appeal in RA-CW-159-2020 in CWP-27706-2017.

For the reasons mentioned in the application which is duly supported by the affidavit of Amarinder Singh Manias, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh, the same is allowed.

Delay of 58 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

Learned counsel for the appellants after arguing for some time has restricted the prayer limited to the extent of reducing the amount of fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/- ordered to be deposited by Mr. Amarinder Singh Manias, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh personally.

Having considered the prayer of counsel for the appellants, who states on instructions from Mr. Rahul Attri, ADA, Haryana Roadways that the fine as imposed in the appealed judgment/order be reduced to half of what has been imposed to be paid by Mr. Amarinder Singh Manias personally and the remaining amount would be paid by the Department of Transport/Haryana Roadways.

In the light of the above, by taking a lenient view, we reduce the amount of fine to be personally paid by Mr. Amarinder Singh Manias, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh to Rs.25,000/-. The remaining Rs.25,000/- be paid by the Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh as per the statement of the counsel for the appellant given on instructions as recorded above.

With these observations, the present appeal as well as the miscellaneous application stand disposed of.
