1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel for respondent states that petitioner Nos.1 and 3 to 6 have been released revised pension in terms of the undertaking given before Hon'ble the Division Bench in CWPNo.18756 of 2011 on 23.07.2019, while revised pension payable to petitioner No.2 has been determined and paid however arrears in respect thereto would be paid by 10.01.2021.

3. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such, while granting liberty to petitioner No.2 to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant.

4. In view of the position as noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, with liberty to petitioner No.2 to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant.
