The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 553 dated 16.09.2020, registered under Sections 376(i), 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 16.10.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions from ASI Rimpal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, she is still required for further investigation.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 16.10.2020, is made absolute

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing her a written notice in this regard.

Liberty is granted to petitioner to join investigation in the presence of her counsel.
