Petitioner has filed the present revision petition for setting aside the order dated 25.04.2019 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ambala, whereby the petition filed by the respondent-wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C., was allowed directing the petitioner to pay maintenance @ ₹10,000/- per month besides litigation expenses ₹11,000/-.
